HIWU reminds Covered Persons of the risks associated with administering compounded products to Covered Horses under the Anti-Doping and Medication Control (ADMC) Program. Since the launch of the ADMC Program, HIWU has identified two potential violations in which it was determined that a compounded product was contaminated with Prohibited Substance(s) at the point of manufacture. While the Responsible Person (e.g., trainer) may be determined to bear no Fault or Negligence or no Significant Fault or Negligence in these types of cases, the presence of a Prohibited Substance in a Covered Horse's sample will result in the disqualification of race results regardless of how the substance was introduced into the horse.
